Grove Municipal Services Authority was a private entity founded in 1957. Grove Municipal Services Authority is now owned and operated by The City of Grove governed by a Board comprised of five members. In addition to providing gas to the Grove area we also sell gas to Afton, Fairland, Jay and Delaware County Rural Water and Gas District Numbers 6, 9 and 10. We bill approximately 4,500 residential, commercial and industrial gas customers. Grove Municipal Services Authority has 19 miles of transmission pipeline 160 miles of distribution main and service lines. We also provide the area with water and sewer services with a total of 5 Natural Gas operators and 9 Service Men. Our main objective is to provide continuous service to all of our customers in a safe and satisfactory manner.
