Placed in service January 2010, Hawthorn Oil Transportation operates a 12" pipeline that transports crude oil 17.5 miles from a rail facility in a Stroud, Oklahoma industrial site to the centralized crude oil hub in Cushing, Oklahoma. The line has the capability to transport up to 90,000 barrels per day of crude oil.
